Individualized Degree, B.A. or B.S.

General Degree Requirements

Program Requirements:

- A total of 120 semester hours are required for graduation.
- A grade of C- or better is required for any MSU Denver course to be included in the Individualized major or minor.
- An IDP Extended Major requires 60 credit hours, including 30 upper-division credits. No minor is necessary.
- An IDP Major requires 40 credit hours, including 21 upper-division credits. A minor must be chosen from the catalog.
- An IDP Minor requires 20 credit hours, including 6 upper-division credits. A major must be chosen from the catalog.

Additional Program Information:

- A GPA of 2.5 at MSU Denver is required for most IDPs at the time of approval; see your advisor for details or questions.
- IDP students must work with their department and their IDP advisor to determine an appropriate title for the IDP. Some words may not be allowed, and there is a limit to the title length. Your major or minor will appear as "Individualized Degree" on your transcript; the title of the major or extended major will be printed on the diploma.
- A Senior Experience is required for the IDP major and extended major. It will consist of at least 3 credit hours at the 4000 level and may be satisfied in a variety of ways, a course, a seminar, an independent study, or an internship.

General Studies Requirements: 33 credits

Students should consult the General Studies Requirements for a list of courses that fulfill the General Studies Requirements for degree completion.

** Students will fulfill the global diversity requirement by taking an approved course within one of the following categories: arts and humanities; historical; natural and physical sciences; or social and behavioral sciences.

Option 1: Individualized Degree: Extended Major, 60 credits

Select credits from previous, transfer, and future coursework to create a coherent major.
Must include at least 30 upper-division credits (3000/4000/9000).
Consult your IDP Advisor and Degree Plan to ensure coursework meets requirements.

Option 2: Individualized Degree: Major, 40 credits

Select credits from previous, transfer, and future coursework to create a coherent major.
Must include at least 21 upper-division credits (3000/4000/9000).
Select a Minor from the current Course Catalog.
Consult your IDP Advisor and Degree Plan to ensure coursework meets requirements.
